**PTAB Ruling Underscores the Strength of Key GTL Patents For Detecting and Controlling  
Contraband Cell Phones in Correctional Facilities**

The PTAB found that Securus failed to show a reasonable likelihood that Securus could demonstrate that any of the claims of these patents were unpatentable. These key GTL technologies detect, monitor, and report contraband cell phone activity to assist GTL customers in combating the growing security threat of illegal phones in their facilities.

"Our patent portfolio covers a wide range of exciting new products that address rising security threats in correctional facilities across the nation," said GTL CEO Brian Oliver. "This PTAB ruling underscores the strength of some of those patents, specifically those protecting technology to detect and control unauthorized wireless devices within a prison."
