The Technology in Motion motorcoach will be available during the following times:

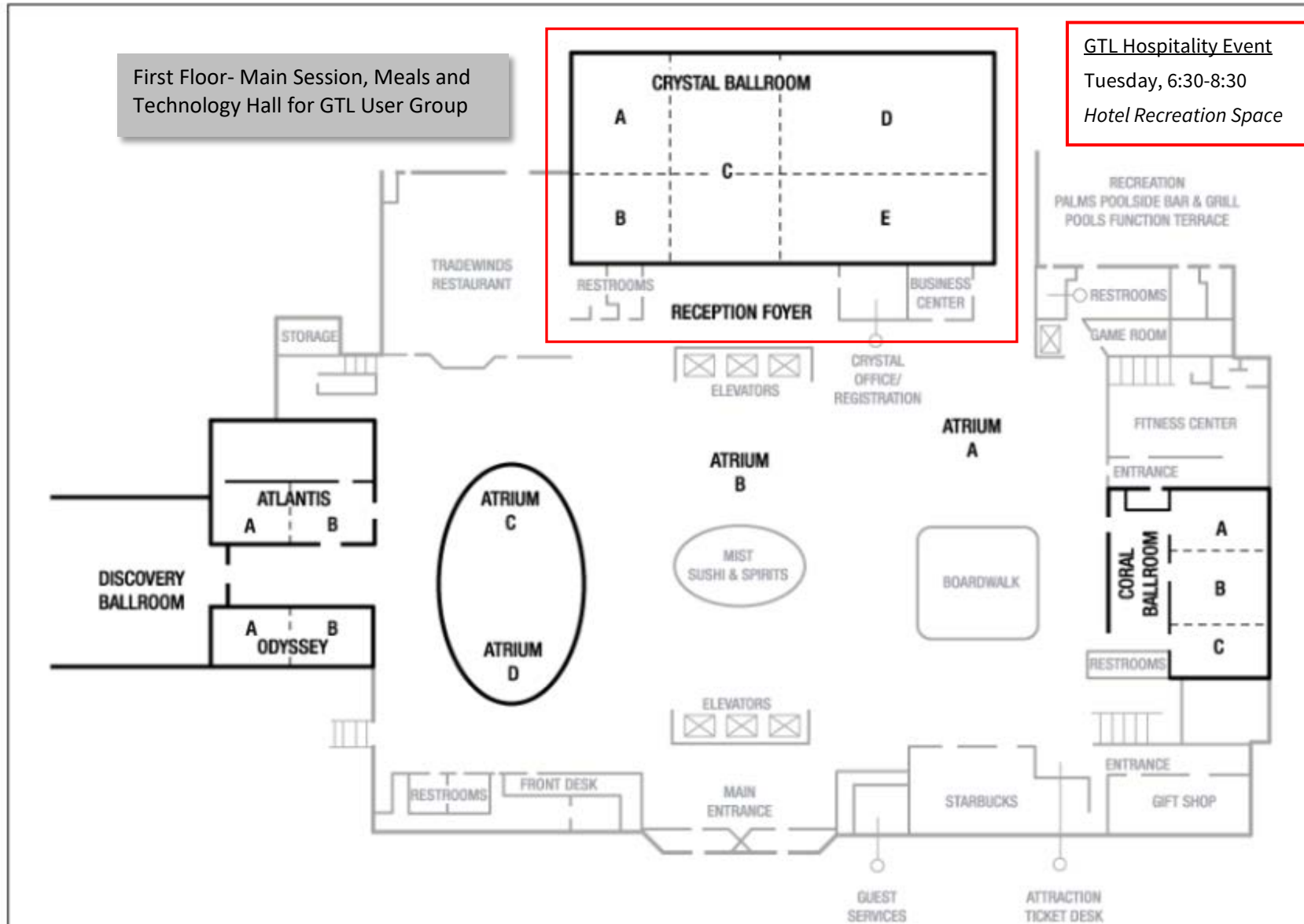
